Riverwoods at Exeter has 4+ miles of trails surrounding the campuses of the Ridge, the Boulders and the Woods.

The Resident Trails Committee monitors, maintains and modifies these trails within RiverWoods properties to promote safe use.

Features to Note

- A Jolly Rand Trail.** The trail follows an ancient cart path. A horse-drawn hay loader remains from the 1930s when this was farmland.
- B Jolly Rand Trail.** Campus Crossing, offices of The RiverWoods Group.
- C Jolly Rand Trail.** Gooch Park has a vehicle drop-off place for accessible walking trail, pickleball, fitness course, fountain, gardens and seating in a gazebo.

- D Brook Loop.** A large boulder, split with a tree growing inside, is an interesting landmark.
- E Quarry Trail.** Remnants from a quarry operation, likely over 150 years ago. The holes drilled into the granite still can be seen.
- F Timber Lane.** Landscaping Facility.
- G Timber Lane.** Goat Shed. Goats living here may be viewed by visitors.
- H The Hemlock Trail** continues on pavement in front of garages to meet the Quarry Trail at the southern end of the garages.
- I Hemlock Loop Trail.** Entry to a short accessible circular trail, flat with firm paving, for those using a wheelchair or rolling walker.
- J Hemlock Trail.** At intersection with Jolly Rand, a bronze plaque honors Pete Richardson for his significant contributions in developing our trail system. Jolly Rand continues north to Rte 111A and is not maintained by RiverWoods.

Trails Information

Emergencies on Trails

- It's preferable to use a walking pole and to walk with a companion. If you will be walking alone, let someone know when and where you expect to be on the trail(s).
- If you have a cell phone, take it with you when you leave for a hike.
- If you are in trouble, dial 911. Also, call the front desk of the appropriate campus. Let that person know that you have called 911 and explain where you are located.
